2. South West Get Together hosted by Gundagai AMC, Sunday 17th April 2016, at Showground.

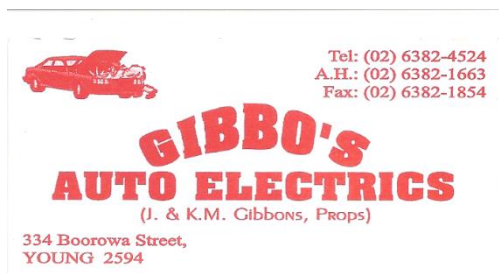
